With their facility cased in Carndonagh, Co. Donegal, Atlanfish makes best use of their latest purpose-built production technology. The company serves the diverse needs of the retail, wholesale, and foodservice trade in Ireland and the rest of Europe. They've also become a leading producer of cooked shellfish products in the Japanese market.

Sustainability has always been a key consideration for Atlanfish who harvest all their raw materials from the sea and acknowledge their resulting dependency on a clean, healthy environment to deliver their high-quality products.

Spotlight Target Area: Energy/ Emissions

In 2022, Atlanfish has made excellent progress towards their goals to reduce energy use across the factory. While the pasteurizing and freezing of crab meat is inherently energy reliant, they have exceeded their initial goal for energy reduction by 12%.

One of the key initiatives the business completed was to review the door seals on all their refrigerators to ensure that they can run as efficiently as possible and to ensure no unnecessary cold air is released. As a result, the member could improve their energy efficiency and reduce unnecessary emissions from increased cooling requirements in their refrigeration systems.

Additionally, Atlanfish have initiated the installation of solar panels onsite, planning to reduce their carbon emissions in the coming years.
